

# Thank You Letter Guidelines for Chemeketa Foundation Scholarship Recipients

Congratulations on your Foundation scholarship award! While not a requirement, we strongly encourage you to submit a thank you letter and photo via <u>chemeketa.academicworks.com</u> as part of your scholarship acceptance process. Your letter and photo will be sent to the donor(s) who fund your scholarship, and may be used for our Foundation marketing purposes. Please do not include information you are not comfortable sharing, and connect with our office if you have any concerns about having a photo submitted for privacy purposes. See the guidelines and letter examples below, and please note: when providing a thank you letter and photo, please do so on or before the deadline of your scholarship offer. Plagiarized or falsified content will jeopardize your scholarship award.

 Letters less than 300 words will be considered incomplete and we will ask you to resubmit.

#### What to Expect and Next Steps:

- Scholarship offers will be sent to your Chemeketa student email address with a link to your offer which will include the details of the scholarship, required criteria for acceptance, and a note or profile identifying your scholarship donor(s).
- Once you receive an offer, compose a letter, written from the heart, and carefully proofread.
  - You may utilize the tutoring or writing center for assistance with your letter.
- Please review your donor's bio and the intent of the award and talk about the impact of the scholarship in your letter.
- Letters that are clearly plagiarized from the examples or generated using AI will not be accepted and may result in the loss of your scholarship.
- Thank you letters should be between 300-1000 words

## Thank You Letter Requirements:

1. Address the letter to your donor(s)

This will be listed on the details of your offer and examples may include:

"Dear Paul," "Dear friends and family of XXXX" "Dear Child Care Scholarship Donors"

- 2. Share what the scholarship means to you and how it will assist you in your educational goals Ex: If your scholarship is specifically for students facing obstacles, student parents, first generation students, those working while attending college, etc; your thank you letter should mention those elements and how this award may help remove barriers.
- 3. Share a bit about yourself and your path to Chemeketa
- 4. Include your academic goals at Chemeketa including how long you have attended
- 5. Share your future education or career goals post-Chemeketa
- 6. Thank your scholarship donor for their support of Chemeketa students
